

Essential Unit Outcomes

The PBS Team will:

- Create, with staff input, the school-wide expectations
- Create a system to teach the school-wide expectations:
 - Lessons, role-plays, PowerPoints
 - Instruction schedule
- Create a means to inform new students of the school-wide expectations
- Create an annual schedule to teach all students the school-wide expectations
- Evaluate the effectiveness of behavior instruction through the review of discipline data as well audit and observation results

Staff will:

- Understand the adoption of universal (school-wide) expectations promotes:
 - a culture of consistency and fairness
 - behaviorally specific communication
 - the development of behavior curriculum
 - the use of reinforcement and correction of student behavior
- Adopt a set of school-wide expectations which are:
 - Small in number (3-5)
 - Positively stated
 - Defined by location
- Understand the importance of systematically teaching the expectations on a school-wide basis
- Establish a means to inform parents and new students of the expectations
